It also had pictures so that readers could see the clothes. Even the King of France read the magazine. He loved reading it, so he decided it should appear once a month.

The first fashion magazine for women, the *Ladies' Mercury*, appeared in London in 1693. In it, women could read about the latest fashions. They could also send in letters with questions about fashion and the magazine wrote its answers. By the beginning of the 18th century, there were many different magazines and all the most fashionable people in Europe read them.

Fashion magazines from 300 years ago didn't look like today's magazines, but the topics in them were just the same – how to look good and stay in fashion!
