

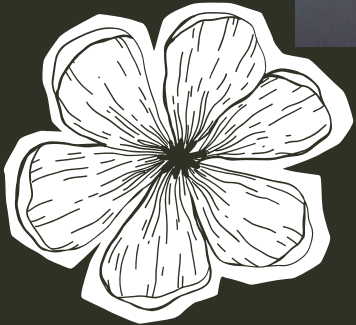

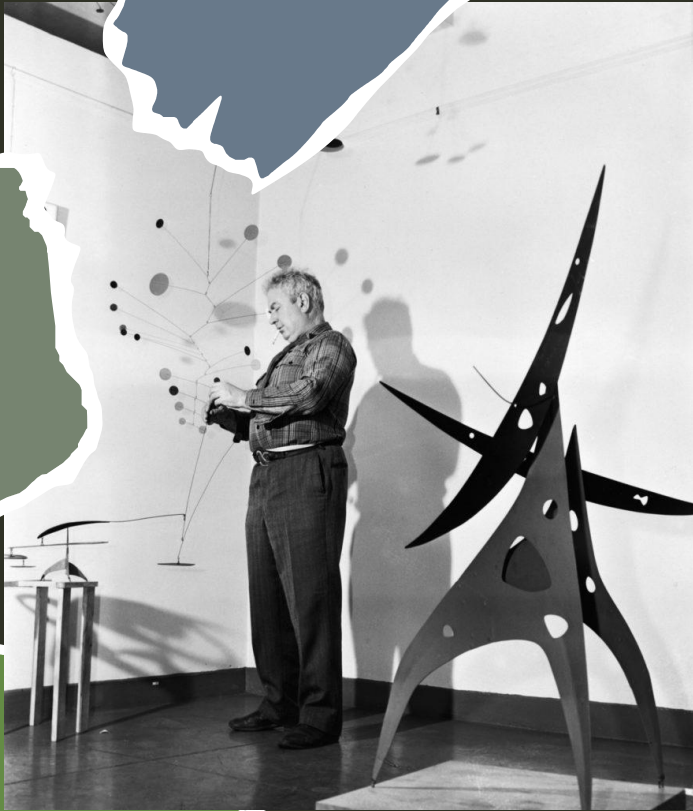

Alexander Calder was born in Philadelphia the day: 22 of August the 1898, he was the son of the sculptor Alexander Stirling Calder, known for his public sculptures, he was dead due to a vascular malady.

His artistic life

Alexander Calder will be an American sculptor, painter, and drawing. He is particularly known for being the creator of mobiles, a type of kinetic sculptures that move thanks to the action of a motor or the action of air currents.

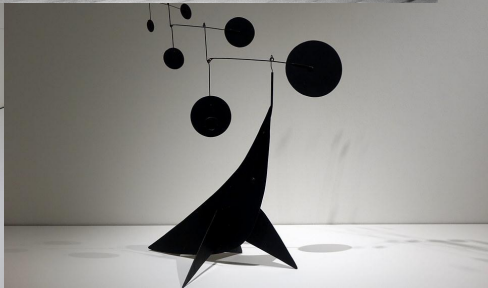
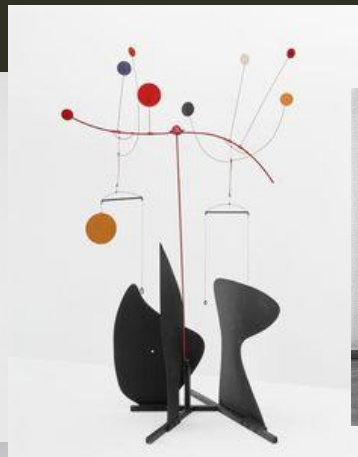
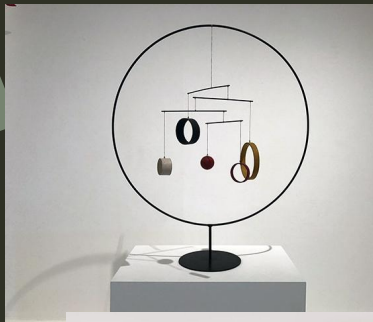
Colors

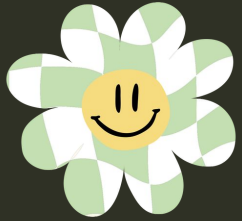
